<u>Committees</u>—We have several committees to work on with other members. The marketing/Fundraising and Programming/Show Committees are the main ones, and they have various tasks that need to be done to help make our exhibits a success.

Held from 5-7 pm on the First Friday of the month. <u>Maintenance/Handyman</u> - work to help keep the facility in good condition. <u>Housekeeping/Cleaning</u> - help make the building look pleasing to guests, such as light cleaning, vacuuming, and organizing.


